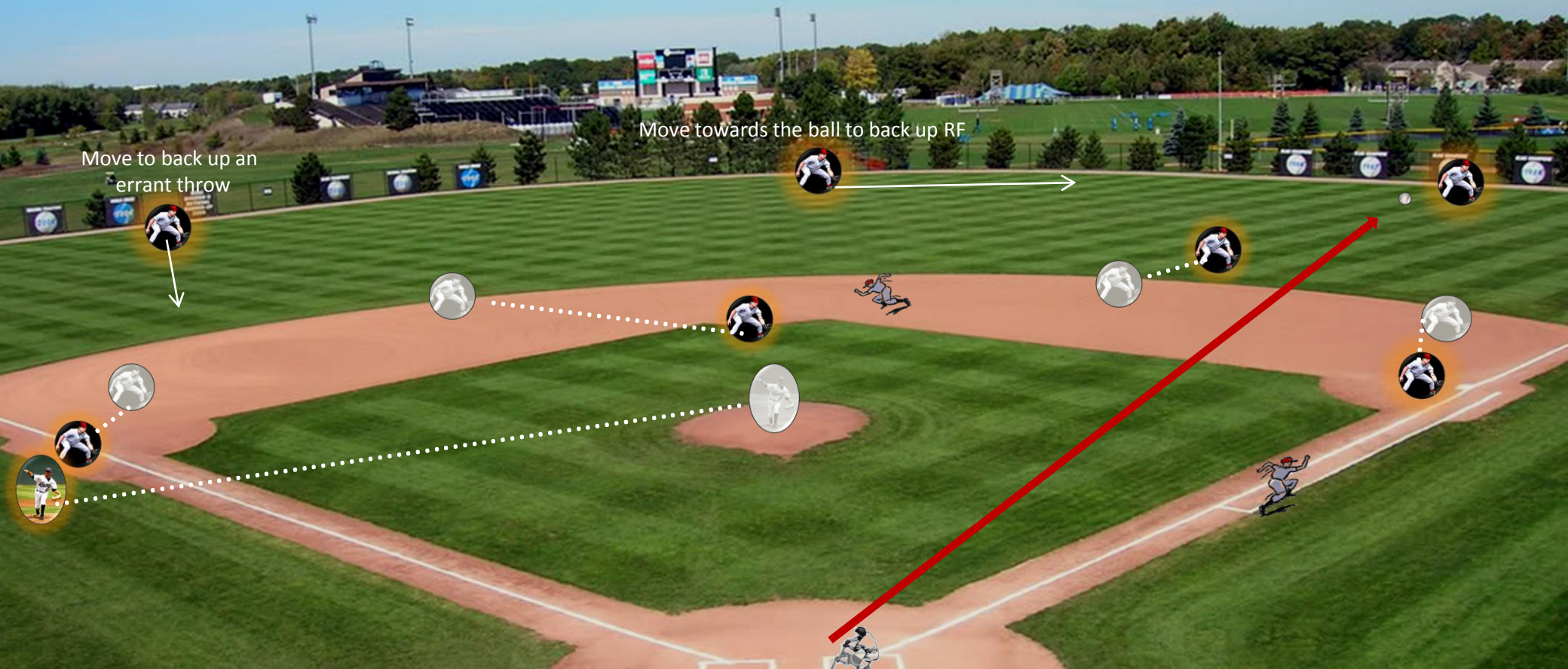


**Runner on 1<sup>st</sup> base. A single to RIGHT field  
CUT-OFF to 3<sup>rd</sup> Base**



Move to back up an errant throw

Move towards the ball to back up RF

- The 2<sup>nd</sup> Baseman goes out as the cut-off man for the right fielder .
- The Shortstop moves to a position that is *to the pitcher's side of 2<sup>nd</sup> base*, but close enough to the base to make a play at 2<sup>nd</sup>. *This is to cause the runner to make a wider turn around 2<sup>nd</sup>*. He should be lined up with 3<sup>rd</sup> base. He directs the 2<sup>nd</sup> baseman and lines him up with the right fielder and 3<sup>rd</sup> base.
- The RF should try to throw to the Shortstop, but has to at least make a GOOD throw to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Baseman.

- The 1<sup>st</sup> Baseman takes his "normal" position to try to make the hitter take a wider turn around 1<sup>st</sup> base.
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> Baseman covers 3<sup>rd</sup> base and lines up the Shortstop with the RF.
- The Pitcher backs up 3<sup>rd</sup> base.
