Age Cut-Offs

For the 2018 season, the cut off age date has been moved to 31st August. i.e. to qualify for U15, the player would need to be Under 15 years of age on 31st August 2018. Age groups by school year are:

Teeball (U-9) – (school years 1, 2 and 3)

Minors (U-11) – (school years 4 and 5)

Majors (U-13) – (school years 6 and 7)

Juniors (U-15) – (school years 8 and 9)

Seniors (U-17) – (school years 10 and 11)

Dates

- Season will begin on Saturday 7th April and run until Saturday July 28th
- There will be pre-season indoor training for those who are interested on each Sunday afternoon in March
- We will run midweek training sessions on a Thursday evening during May, June and July
- BBF game schedule will be released nearer the start of the season

- A playing jersey will be loaned to all players on game day, or can be loaned for the season on payment of a refundable £40 deposit (cheque preferred).
