## **Age Cut-Offs**

For the 2018 season, the cut off age date has been moved to 31<sup>st</sup> August. i.e. to qualify for U15, the player would need to be Under 15 years of age on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018. Age groups by school year are:

Teeball (U-9) –  $(school\ years\ 1,\ 2\ and\ 3)$ 

Minors (U-11) – (school years 4 and 5)

Majors (U-13) – (school years 6 and 7)

Juniors (U-15) – (school years 8 and 9)

Seniors (U-17) – (school years 10 and 11)

#### **Dates**

- Season will begin on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> April and run until Saturday July 28<sup>th</sup>
- There will be pre-season indoor training for those who are interested on each Sunday afternoon in March
- We will run midweek training sessions on a Thursday evening during May, June and July
- BBF game schedule will be released nearer the start of the season

#### **Equipment and Uniform**

- All equipment is provided, although all players are welcome to bring their own
- A playing jersey will be loaned to all players on game day, or can be loaned for the season on payment of a refundable £40 deposit (cheque preferred).
- Caps and pants can be purchased from the club
