### Age Cut-Offs

For the 2019 season, the cut off age date has been moved to 31<sup>st</sup> August. i.e. to qualify for U15, the player would need to be Under 15 years of age on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019. Age groups by school year are:

Teeball (U-9) – (school years 1, 2 and 3) Minors (U-11) – (school years 4 and 5)

Majors (U-13) – (school years 6 and 7) Juniors (U-15) – (school years 8 and 9)

Seniors (U-18) – (school years 10, 11, 12)

### Dates

- Season will begin on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> April and run until Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup>
- There will be pre-season indoor training for those who are interested on each Sunday afternoon in March (3<sup>rd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup>). There will be one week off before we move outdoors (Mar 31<sup>st</sup>) and Easter Saturday will also be an off week
- We will run midweek training sessions on a Wednesday evening during May, June and July
- Game schedule with other BBF teams will be released nearer the start of the season

### Equipment and Uniform

- All equipment is provided, although all players are welcome to bring their own
- A playing jersey will be loaned to all players on game day, or can be loaned for the season on payment of a refundable £40 deposit (cheque preferred).
- Replacement caps and t-shirts as well as other clothing can be purchased from the club
