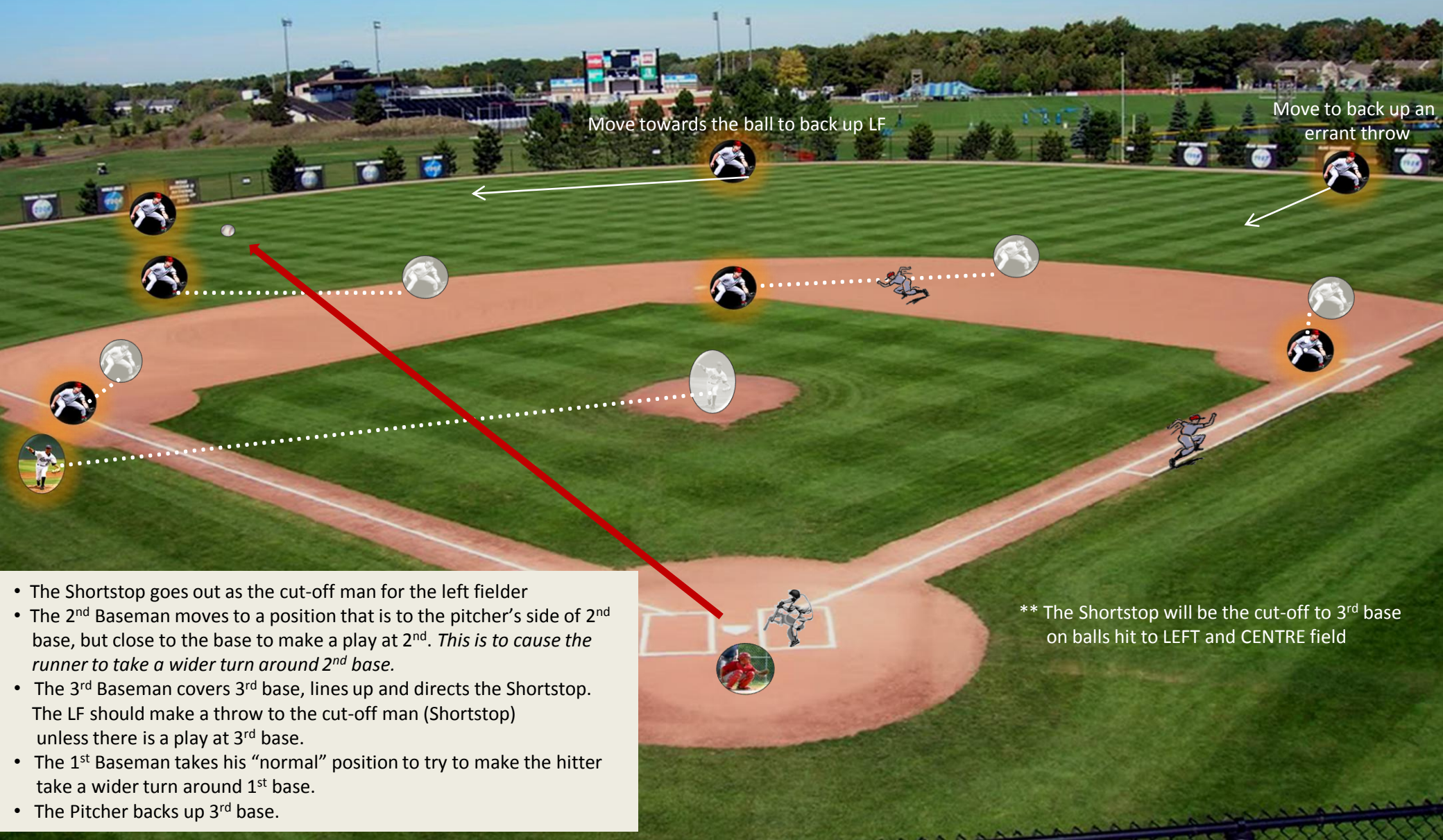


**Runner on 1<sup>st</sup> base. A single to LEFT field  
CUT-OFF to 3<sup>rd</sup> Base**



Move towards the ball to back up LF

Move to back up an errant throw

- The Shortstop goes out as the cut-off man for the left fielder
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> Baseman moves to a position that is to the pitcher's side of 2<sup>nd</sup> base, but close to the base to make a play at 2<sup>nd</sup>. *This is to cause the runner to take a wider turn around 2<sup>nd</sup> base.*
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> Baseman covers 3<sup>rd</sup> base, lines up and directs the Shortstop. The LF should make a throw to the cut-off man (Shortstop) unless there is a play at 3<sup>rd</sup> base.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> Baseman takes his "normal" position to try to make the hitter take a wider turn around 1<sup>st</sup> base.
- The Pitcher backs up 3<sup>rd</sup> base.

\*\* The Shortstop will be the cut-off to 3<sup>rd</sup> base on balls hit to LEFT and CENTRE field
